What Will You Wear?

A wedding is a beautiful occasion and one that has been prepared for over the course of many years. It is the solemn moment when a man and woman give themselves without reserve to each other. So naturally, they would be a bit disappointed if nobody turned up! Through the incarnation, the Lord Jesus has come close to us. Through His sacrifice on the cross, He has given Himself to us and through the celebration of the Eucharist, He continues to invite us to His wedding feast. In ancient Israel, it would have been the high of rudeness to turn up in inappropriate attire, without a wedding garment. In baptism, we all received a white garment of some variety. The words accompanying this ritual action are: “See in this white garment the outward sign of your Christian dignity. Bring that dignity unstained into the everlasting life of heaven.” So the question is: what is the state of your wedding garment? And in its current state, would our Lord admit you to the wedding feast? It is not too late to give that garment a good and thorough wash!
