## 22nd October 2023 - 29th Sunday in Ordinary Time

### How Many Gods Do You Worship?

In the Gospel today, Jesus is handed a coin. On the reverse side, the coin bears the image of the Roman emperor of the time, Caesar Augustus. Now, this is significant for two reasons: firstly, it is a powerful reminder of who rules the roost and to whom one owes their allegiance, and secondly, it is an image of Caesar, emperor and god, to whom the people must pay homage and offer worship. Jesus teaches us that as Christians, we must endeavour to be good citizens, engaged in building up society for the common good, but He also teaches us that we are to have but one God, the Lord of heaven and earth and no form of hobby, social activity or activism can ever replace worship of the living God. So this week let us take a moment to consider how many gods we worship, where does God feature on our list of priorities and, if He does not occupy the first place, then why not?
