Men's Group/Women's Group for Lent - As Lent is already rapidly approaching (14th February is Ash Wednesday), we shall begin a men's group and a women's group meeting weekly to reflect on our experience of Lent and to undertake some spiritual exercise together.

Shrove Tuesday - Tuesday, 13th February — "shrove" from the Old English, to shrive or to confess, is the last day before Lent begins. Traditionally, we would use up animal products such as butter and eggs as these were not allowed during the Lenten fast. We will have pancakes in the Aquinas Hall beginning at 7pm.

Ash Wednesday Masses with the Imposition of Ashes - Wednesday 14th February, 8am & 6pm.

Carmelite Spirituality - This Friday, (16th Feb), Mr John Fellows, a lay Carmelite will come to talk to us about the Brown Scapular of Our Lady and the spirituality of the Carmelite Order. A must for anybody who already wears the Brown Scapular and any who wish to be invested with it this semester.
